What is it?

Bit.ly is a tool that allows users to create custom URL addresses that allow for easier access to things like shared items on Google Drive, YouTube videos, and other online resources.

What does it do?

In addition to creating shorter URL addresses, Bit.ly can also track usage by showing the date and frequency of interactions.
