Make sure you the first letter is capital and all other letters are lowercase, neat and carefully written. Practice learning and saying the city and state where you live. Begin learning to say your address and phone number by heart. Writing practice is encouraged as well, but optional for address and phone number. _____

5. Complete Math addition sentences by folding a piece of paper into fourths (in half and then half the other way to make 4 square sections). Write (or have a family member help you write) the following number sentences in each of the 8 sections (front and back): $4+1=$ $3+2=$ $5+6=$ $7+1=$ $8+3=$ $9+0=$ $4+4=$ $6+4=$ Draw a picture showing what each addition sentence says (ex. $2+1$ draw a group of two simply drawn objects, such as smiley faces, then a group of 1 smiley face...add all together and write the numeral answer!
